ECC 145 Diverse Populations and Families

3 Credits. 3 Lecture Hours. 0 Lab Hour.

A course on concepts and techniques for teaching diverse populations in early childhood settings. Topics include: developing positive relationships in diverse family units, inclusion, multiculturalism, and adapting learning environments to include gifted children and children with disabilities.

ECC 198 First Year Special Topics in Early Child Care 1-9 Credits. 0 Lecture Hour. 0 Lab Hour.

A course on selected topics related to Early Child Care, which gives students opportunities to study information not currently covered in other courses. Grades issued are A, B, C, D, or F. Prerequisites: Vary by section

ECC 199 First Year Independent Project in Early Child Care 1-9 Credits. 0 Lecture Hour. 0 Lab Hour.

A project related to Early Child Care that is completed by one or more students to meet specific educational goals. Projects must have prior approval and supervision by Early Child Care faculty. Grades issued are Satisfactory or Unsatisfactory.

ECC 298 Second Year Special Topics in Early Child Care 1-9 Credits. 0 Lecture Hour. 0 Lab Hour.

A course on selected topics related to Early Child Care, which gives students opportunities to study information not currently covered in other courses. Grades issued are A, B, C, D, or F. Prerequisites: Vary by section

ECC 299 Second Year Independent Project in Early Child Care 0 Credits. 0 Lecture Hour. 0 Lab Hour.

A project related to Early Child Care that is completed by one or more students to meet specific educational goals. Projects must have prior approval and supervision by Early Child Care faculty. Grades issued are Satisfactory or Unsatisfactory. Prerequisites: Vary by section 1
