

Leadership Certificates

The Leadership department offers two certificates, designed to give students a theoretical and practical knowledge of leadership:

- The Leadership Certificate (LDRC) (<http://catalog.cincinnati.state.edu/academicdivisionsanddegreeandcertificateprograms/humanitiesandsciencesdivision/leadership/ldrc/>) complements many degree programs. Students develop skills that apply to leadership positions in a variety of work and community environments, including skills in communication, small group facilitation, critical analysis, and problem solving.
- The Community Leadership Certificate (CLDC) (<http://catalog.cincinnati.state.edu/academicdivisionsanddegreeandcertificateprograms/humanitiesandsciencesdivision/leadership/cldc/>) is intended for individuals employed at a community or public service agency who wish to gain leadership skills to assist in possible advancement within the agency.
