Information Management Technologies programs prepare students for employment in a variety of general and specialized office settings.

The Administrative Assistant (<http://catalog.cincinnati.state.edu/archives/2021-2022/academicdivisionsanddegreeandcertificateprograms/businessandtechnologiesdivision/informationmanagementtechnologies/aop/>) associate's degree program includes technical skill development, understanding of business and management principles, and cooperative education work experience. Students choose one of three tracks:

- Administrative Assistant
- Legal Administrative Assistant
- Medical Administrative Assistant

Minimum grades of C are required for all technical courses.

Information Management Technologies also offers a certificate program:
